Communication Language and Literacy

We have started our new theme of "Our Special World" and this week have been using non fiction books and materials to find out about our local environment. FS1 and nursery have been looking at buildings around the school boundaries and what they are used for.

Vocabulary: World, Earth, country, map, globe, England, St. Neots, London, town, environment, school environment, home, house, flat, factory, school, office.

Mathematics

This week the FS2 children have continued to learn about number and used this knowledge to support their learning with calculation and subtraction. They have started to record number sentences. FS1 and nursery are matching numerals to number quantities.

Vocabulary: Count, number, numeral, total, most, least, addition, add, makes, same, least, number sentence, subtraction, take away.
