

Year Six Curriculum Information-Summer Term 2014

Welcome back to Winhills. Below is an outline of what we will be covering in the curriculum over the term in year six.

<p style="text-align: center;">Literacy</p> 	<p>As the children are preparing for SATs in May, they will focus on reading comprehension. This will cover a wide range of text types including reports, poetry, advertisements and narrative. The children will recap assessment technique to prepare them thoroughly for the assessments. In addition to this they will be developing their spelling, punctuation and grammar skills in preparation for the SPAG assessment.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Numeracy</p> 	<p>The children and Mrs Blackhurst have identified areas of Numeracy to work on in preparation for SATs. In addition to revising fractions, decimals, graph reading and the four operations, the children will gain more experience of answering SATs-style questions. Maths Whizz has been uncapped for year 6 which means they have unlimited access to this superb resource.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p> 	<p>Work will focus this term on the topics of Light, Circuits and Sex Education. The children will investigate Light, how it travels and what it is made of. The children will conduct experiments and investigations into how circuits work and the factors that affect their success.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">ICT</p> 	<p>This term the children will continue to use ICT across a range of lessons. We will using a variety of maths websites which the children can also access from home, and looking at using multimedia presentations in literacy.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Breakfast Club</p> 	<p>SATS booster breakfast club and after school clubs are still running until Thursday 8th May. All children in year 6 are invited to attend Monday-Thursday mornings from 8 a.m. They will be given breakfast and a session of literacy or maths revision. Literacy booster club is available on Tuesdays 3.15 p.m. - 4p.m. Maths booster club is on Thursdays 3.15 p.m. - 4 p.m.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">P.E</p> 	<p>This term the children will be receiving football coaching after SATs. They will continue to work with Mr Franco on Thursday afternoons. They will also have a session of Street Dance each week. Both these activities are designed to give the children a range of sporting experiences and develop general fitness.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Music</p> 	<p>There will be a session of music with Mrs Walden on Wednesday afternoons. This will develop a greater sense of rhythmic awareness and knowledge of World Music. Year 6 will also play the lead roles in our school musical. Rehearsals for this will start after SATs.</p>
