<p><b><u>Communication and Language</u></b></p> <p>The children will begin to expand their know of powerful vocabulary through Drawing Club. They will learn how to communicate, share their ideas, thoughts and opinions with one another clearly and calmly. In order to further develop their understanding subjects, the children will also learn how to ask appropriate and relevant questions.</p>	<p><b><u>Personal, Social and emotional development</u></b></p> <p>Throughout the term, the children will learn to communicate in small groups, sharing ideas and methods; as well solve problems with each other. They will learn how to select tools for the task they have been set and talk to others about their needs. We will celebrate all of our similarities and differences in Einstein class. The children will learn how to talk about their emotions and communicate them to those around them.</p>	<p><b><u>Physical Development</u></b></p> <p>Every week, the children will take part in P.E lessons. They will develop their co-ordination, balance, gross and fine motor skills. The large construction, bats and balls, skipping ropes and scooters are always available for the children to challenge themselves. Throughout the term, the children will be taught how to grip pencils and paintbrushes to improve and refine their mark making.</p>
<p><b><u>Understanding the world</u></b></p> <p>The children will discuss different celebrations and traditions that are important to them and their families. We will specifically learn about Diwali and Harvest. The children will take part in various bug hunts and season spotting as we change into winter from Autumn. In the class, we will investigate materials and their properties. The children will investigate to find answers to be able to sort the materials. From these investigations the children will learn to make predictions and apply their knowledge accordingly. They will learn the names and functions of different body parts and ways in which to stay healthy and safe.</p>	<p><b><u>Einstein Class – Autumn Term 2024</u></b></p> <div></div> <p><b><u>All About Me</u></b> <b><u>Terrific Tales!</u></b></p>	<p><b><u>Expressive arts and design</u></b></p> <p>To begin with, the children will explore colours and mixing them. As part of our topic ‘Marvellous Me’ the children will also be creating their own self-portraits inspired by a range of artists such as Rembrandt, de Vinci, Van Gogh and Hanoch Piven To create wonderful objects and creations, they will be taught a range of permanent and temporary joins to improve their junk modelling creations. We will have singing and music sessions. The children will be able to explore a range of instruments.</p>
<p><b><u>Literacy</u></b></p> <p>The children will be learning to identify, segment and blend sounds in phonics as well as learning to read some tricky words on sight. They will learn to read and write through small focused group work and constant access to games and activities. They will share a variety of texts and rhymes during Drawing Club and write invitations, letters, lists, story maps and poems during shared writing times, learning the stories and re-inventing them with their own ideas.</p>		<p><b><u>Maths</u></b></p> <p>This term the children will develop their counting skills; making sure they are accurate up to 20. They will order quantities and numerals on number lines, varying their starting place. The children will use Numicon, multilink, counting bears, counters to name a few of tools that will help them visualise number. They will begin to record numbers in writing and explore the concepts of more, less, addition and subtraction. They will move on to learn the names of 2D and 3D shapes and group them according to their properties.</p>
