You can record this as BT in the comments section.</p>	<p>Spellings are given out on a Wednesday and need to be handed in the following Monday. The children are expected to use their spellings in sentences as well as practising them. There will be a spelling quiz on a Monday afternoon.</p>	<p>The children need to complete their tasks on MyMaths and 15 minutes of Times Table Rock Stars homework each week.</p> <p>The week will run from a Friday to a Thursday night. We will be checking MyMaths and TT Rock Stars on a Friday morning to see if they have completed the correct number of minutes.</p>	<p>PE will be on a Wednesday morning. Please ensure that your child has an appropriate PE kit for the changing weather. This includes suitable footwear. Earrings must be removed and long hair must be completely tied up.</p> <p>On a Friday, the children will have Outdoor Learning with Miss Burnett. Please ensure they come into school with their wellies in a bag and a pair of shoes they are happy to wear outside. It would also be helpful for the children to have a raincoat with them as the weather changes.</p>	<p>Please ensure that your child is dressed appropriately for the changing weather. This includes a suitable waterproof coat.</p> <p>Please make sure that all items of clothing are named.</p> <p>All children should bring in a water bottle every day.</p> <p>Other updates will be posted on Class Dojo.</p>
