English:

In English the children have continued with their non-chronological reports. The children have focused on different introductions to write their own. They have moved on to developing their skills at paragraph writing.

In their Read Write Inc lessons, the children have been learning and implementing new sounds within their reading and writing. The children have completed another exciting Big Write based on their RWI book that week.

Year 2 have started an exciting new SPaG (Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar) scheme. Each week a different 'Spelling Alien' teaches the children new spellings.

Mathematics:

In Miss Larbey's Maths groups, the children have been exploring addition and subtraction on a number line. They have applied these new skills to reasoning. The children are going to be learning to solve multiplication problems on a number line, using lots of.

In Miss Brock's and Mrs Goodwin's Maths groups the children have been challenging themselves with place value, time and times tables. Whilst learning about time, the children have focused on daily routine and the key times of the day.
