

WINHILLS Year 1 and Year 2 Fortnightly Newsletter

English

Both Year 1 and 2 have been focusing on the second of Traction Man's adventures, 'Traction Man meets Turbodog'. They have inferred from the front cover and made predictions about the story. They have sequenced the events of the story and used actions to retell it. Year 2 have also written a recount. In Exciting Writing, both Year 1 and 2 imagined that they were Scrubbing Brush and wrote a diary in role. Year 2 have also been completing their reading assessments.

Mathematics

In Year 1 have been learning all about 2D and 3D shapes. They have been identifying the properties of the shapes, including lines of symmetry, and have used these to sort them into categories. The children in Year 2 have also been learning about 2D and 3D shapes. They worked together to find multiple lines of symmetry a shape has and used their own categories to sort 3D shapes. Both Year 1 and Year 2 have also been completing their arithmetic and reasoning assessments.

Science

In Science, we have been looking at the parts of the human body. The children can name the basic parts of their body and label these on a diagram. We have also made posters about how to keep our bodies healthy.

Year 1 and 2 are continuing to enjoy learning all about the changes in life from the past to the present. They have been enjoying learning about past time games during their outdoor learning, including hopscotch, skipping and French skipping. On Thursday 7th March, the children enjoyed World Book Day. They looked fantastic in their costumes and enjoyed listening to a variety of stories and completing activities in the afternoon.
