English:

In English the children have been focusing on how to write speech. The children have learnt how to correctly punctuate speech as well as learning and using different words for 'said' in their writing. They also have taken inspiration from the book 'Zog' by Julia Donaldson and written, edited and improved character descriptions.

In their Read, Write, Inc lessons the children have been learning and implementing new sounds within their reading and writing.

Year 1 have been working extremely hard on their phonic skills since returning from half term. The children have been working hard reading, sounding out and recognising all their sounds.

Mathematics:

In Miss Larbey's Maths groups, the children have been entering the world of fractions. The children have learnt how to find different fractions of amounts.

In Miss Brock's and Mrs Goodwin's Maths groups the children have been exploring measure. This week they have been focusing on weight in particular. The children have measured a range of items using non-standard and standard measures.

Science:

In Key Stage 1, the children are continuing to focus on their topic of 'Materials'. The children are able to describe the different properties of different materials.

The children will be researching different materials, discovering how they are made and whether or not the material is manmade or natural.
