Year 3

English

Moonstone class have started to identify the key features of non-chronological reports. We have been able to identify these in a range of non-fiction texts. Each child has chosen a topic to research and will be creating their own report.

Mathematics

The children have been focusing on learning their 3, 4 and 8 times table facts. We have also been focusing on division using the selected times tables. Moonstone have recently started to apply the grid method to show their multiplication workings out.

Science

In Science we are looking into the word of rocks. The children have already identified and grouped various different rocks. We will begin to classify different rocks and will be studying how fossils are formed.
