Year 3

English

The children have been learning the differences between formal and informal letters. They have used the features of persuasive letters in their own writing and have started to edit and improve their letters.

Mathematics

The children learnt to solve various 2D and 3D shape problems and then moved on to fractions. They practised ordering, subtracting, adding and finding equivalent fractions. They will need to use all these skills when they begin solving fraction problems.

Science

Moonstone class have been looking into the world of forces and magnets. The children have investigated different surfaces, found magnetic materials and investigated the strength of magnets.

Year 4

English
