### Year 3

#### English

This week in English, Year 3 have been writing and editing their own innovated story of 'Leon and the Place Between'. They have been focussing on using commas to mark clauses, using a variety of sentence starters and exciting vocabulary. They have also applied these skills in their exciting writing.

#### Maths

In Math, Year 3 have been learning about mass and capacity. They have been measuring amounts, identifying increments on the scales and they have added and subtracted amounts.

#### Science

Year 3 are learning about plants. They have been focussing on how different plants adapt to different environments.

## Year 4

#### English

This week in English, Year 4 have been practising their SpaG skills. They have been working on using correct speech punctuation, identifying singular and plural nouns and practising using the possessive. They applied these skills successfully in their science writing.

#### Maths

In Maths, Year 4 have been learning all about money. They have been looking at the values of coins and notes and then practising tricky word problems that involve money.

#### Science

Year 4 have now finished their unit all about Solids, Liquids and Gases. They learnt all about the Water Cycle and worked in pairs to create very information leaflets. Their next unit will be all about Electricity.

The children have been hard at work in the ICE zone, as always, and are thoroughly enjoying their Home and Away topic. They started the unit with a trip to the local museum where they learnt all about town's history. They have been busy creating their own fact files on the town and comparing it to a European city.
